## Timeline of Development

**2018** – Conduct two international trauma awareness trips responding to refugee displacement and hurricane

Fall 2018- Convert School of Social Work to trauma-informed curriculum

**2019** – Conduct one domestic and one international trauma awareness trip

Fall 2019 - Establish International Center for Trauma Education & Care under School of Social Work

**Fall 2019**-Early 2020 – conduct miscellaneous trauma-aware trainings on AU campus, including to senior Administrative team

**Spring 2020** – COVID cancels planned trips, which is re-scheduled to Zoom

**2020-2022** – Conduct trauma awareness Zoom trainings for campus, local, national, and international audiences totaling 6,500 people

**Fall 2021** – Obtain first paid 2 year contract with local school district to provide trauma education/consultation to staff

**Fall 2022** – Receive internal funding to partner with five on-campus health & education departments to implement trauma-informed course design, inc. student mini-courses and Trauma Care Café

**Spring 2023** – Receive multiple requests to expand trauma awareness training across campus – Student Life, Math Department, Theological Seminary, Dormitory Staff, Campus Safety, etc.

**Summer 2023** – Provost offers FTE to develop trauma training modules and consultation services for higher education, faith-based organizations, and Emergency Medical Service faculty.

**Summer 2023** – Partner with Andrews Service Corporation to develop training modules, consultation services, and service delivery structures for trauma education.

**Fall 2023** - Provide contracted trauma training services and consultation to churches, faith-based organizations, and external universities.

Fall 2023 – To date, have provided broad range of trauma aware, trauma informed, and trauma infused services to 14,000 of people on local, national, and international levels.
