

Workforce Demand is Creating New Opportunities

The World Health Organization estimates a projected **shortfall of 10 million healthcare workers** by 2030.

30% of current U.S. job openings in major metropolitan areas are in STEM fields, however, only 11% of the U.S. population has a degree in STEM.

Employment in management occupations is projected to grow 8% over the next decade, resulting in **over 800,00 new jobs.**





68% of adults considering enrollment in a higher education program now prefer non-degree pathways.




76% of employers surveyed are more likely to hire a candidate who has earned a professional certificate.



It's estimated that **39 million adults** have completed some college but **left without a degree or credential**, as of July 2020.



4.8% increase in enrollment in **undergraduate nondegree credentials** between spring 2022 and 2023.
