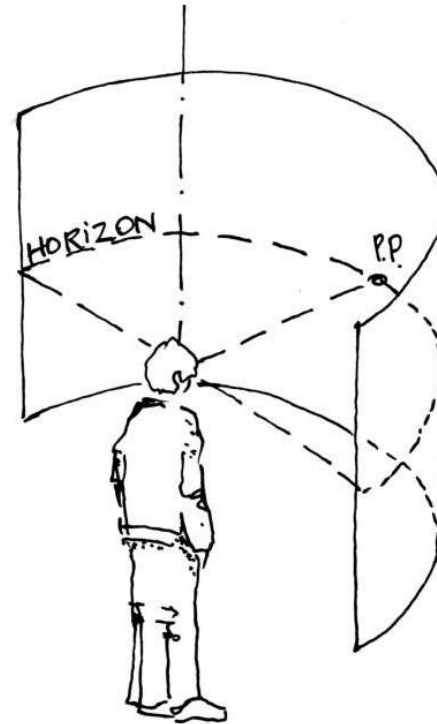

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Q: How have student protests, lists of demands, or other forms of student engagement around inclusive excellence affected your work and how have you partnered with students to create positive change?



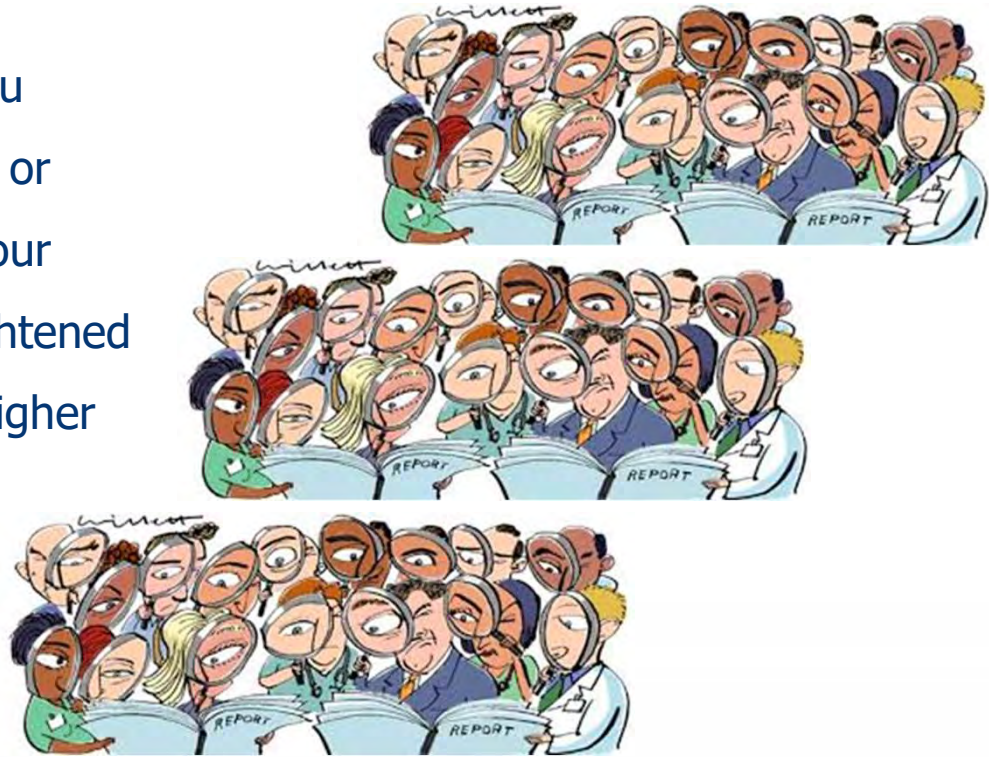
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Q: In what ways have you modified your processes, or felt pressure to modify your practices due to the heightened scrutiny of DEI work in higher education?

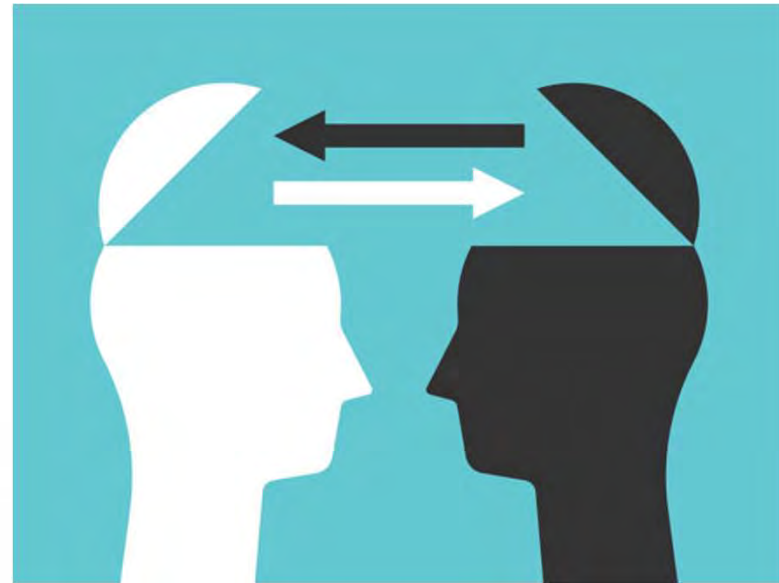

What are some of the no-cost or low-cost activities that you are finding have the most impact on your campus, particularly in the Academic Affairs realm?

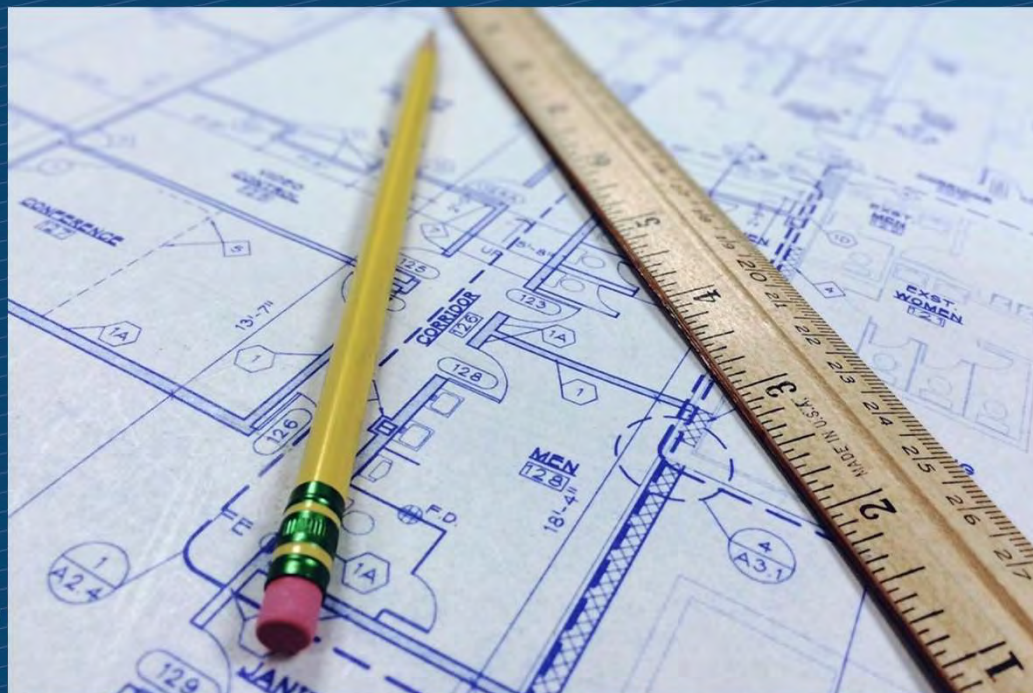
